Meeting Minutes

4. Adoption of 2021 AGM minutes:

M/S Nancy Wilson/Pat Silver that the minutes of the 2021 AGM be adopted as circulated. Carried.

5. **2022 Financial Report:** Treasurer Pat Silver

Summary of 2021 income and expenses:

- Grant income of \$51,938 was almost double 2020's of \$27,669
- Donations of 14,550 were more than double 2020's of \$5,700

Summary of larger 2021 expenses:

- \$5,250 fees for consultant who coached the board in strategic planning
- \$12,147 for wages for education and outreach coordinator
- \$8,131 for wages for summer student for outreach and education
- \$7,973 for a fish study

\$6,086 for water quality and quantity testing and equipment.

The year 2021 ended with a surplus of \$23,399 carried over to 2022 programs.

Summary of 2022 income so far: Jan 1-Sept 28:

- Grant income of \$55,498, higher than 2021
- Donations of \$4,479

Summary of larger 2022 expenses so far: Jan 1-Sept 28:

- \$35,685 Wages for education and outreach coordinator and summer student
- \$1,523 Accounting fees
- \$1,699 Insurance

A surplus of 2022 income over expenses of \$10,283 remains to be used for the balance of the year or carried forward to 2023 programs.

Discussion: Tom Symington reported that that Columbia Lake Stewardship Society Endowment Fund with the Columbia Valley Community Foundation has reached and slightly surpassed the threshold of \$10,000 this year. CLSS should start receiving a payment from this fund in 2023.

She also thanked our full-time employee Leah Downey and our wonderful 2022 summer student Lucas Fuertes for their hard work on behalf of CLSS.
