2022 Water Quantity Report

"The year concluded by an above normal amount, a consequence of an unusually light May and June. The Columbia River reported a record low water level in the corresponding period a year later." *Dr. Rossini*



2022 Water Quality Report

The monitoring program continued to use the same equipment as reported a decade ago. The data shows some positive improvements in water quality, particularly in regards to phosphorus. The trend in concentrations of nitrate, the highest nutrient, continues down and appears stable. *Dr. Rossini*
